HS TEAMS – GRAD YEARS 2023-2020

Teams in the HS age group will be organized by skill and commitment level, should there be enough for multiple teams in each skill level – teams within in skill level will be organized by age. There is an abbreviated program available for 2020 players details below as well.

BASIC INFORMATION

To accommodate the needs of all of our players, there will be 3 tiers of opportunity for players this season. Each opportunity level will have a varying level of skill and commitment required for participation and each team will receive at a minimum the same level of coaching, development and recruiting emphasis as prior years. ***These tiers ARE NOT based on good vs bad players but are designed to cater to commitment level and interest level in college recruiting as well as national travel.** * There is always the opportunity to be moved up a tier and at the same time a player may be moved down if they are not meeting the expectations of their program.

***2020 Players:** 2020 players will attend an abbreviated Fall/Winter season. They will be able to participate in all practices, training and select tournaments including 7v7s and 1x fall 12v12. 2020 who wish to participate in 360 Elite or Project Midwest must be evaluated 8/24. The goal for the 2020 players will be to prepare them for their final HS Varsity season, continue to provide recruiting assistance if needed, as well as continue to develop college committed players for their future college programs.

Practice schedule and tournament information will mirror the schedules and information below.

Estimated Cost for the season: \$750 *can add additional tournaments a la carte*

Tier 1 – 360 Select (2023-2020): Geared towards players who participate in multiple activities, the schedule for this team is more regionally based with more leniency for practice and tournament conflicts. There will be a heavy emphasis on player & skill development as well as college recruitment

Tier 2– 360 Elite (2023-2020): Geared towards players who are committed to playing at the next level, the schedule for this team is nationally based with little to no leniency for practice and tournament conflicts. In addition to the regular practice schedule, there will be 5-6 mandatory Fall/Winter & Summer practice dates that players must attend in order to be eligible regardless of their evaluation outcome. All tournaments should be considered mandatory. There will be a heavy emphasis on player & skill development as well as intensive player evaluation & college recruitment support for players. This program will be more intense than our current HS program offering for 2018-2019. Players must be evaluated to make this team, evaluations for the elite team will take place 8/24 and those interested must be registered in advance.

Tier 3– Project Midwest Girls (2023-2020): For 2019-2020 this opportunity will be invitation only and will be organized by event. This team is for families and players looking for “more”. It will be a collaboration of top players from Brave Lacrosse STL (Brian Smith, Lindenwood University), MI Elite Grand Rapids (Mackenzie Lawler, Grand Valley State). Players will combine for 3 events across this initial year and will receive feedback and guidance from a variety of coaches while playing in an elite showcase environment with other similar players. Players will be able to attend “camps” to work together and with the participating coaches. Events will be added to the schedule based on interest. This opportunity is only available to players rostered with Players 360, Brave & MI Elite.



Commitment: Tournament and 1 practice the day before the event, PMW Camps when scheduled
